## Health and Wellbeing



This term we will be focussing on **Internet Safety** as a class and will look at factors such as Social media, Mobile phones and Online forums. This will hopefully encourage the children to use these programs safely and securely and develop their skills and knowledge in this area.

This is not intended to put the children off but purely to educate and inform them on using internet appropriately and safely.

P.E will take place on Tuesdays with Mrs Flockton and on a Fridays. Please can you ensure your child has appropriate clothing and footwear for this.

Outdoor Gardening will be every Thursday, please bring appropriate clothing and shoes.



## Literacy



**Listening and Talking:** Some children have already carried out their first talk through their homework activity of Black History Month in Term 1. This term we will be focussing on listening and talking within groups as our topic activities will involve mostly group work. The children will be encouraged to listen to others fairly, share ideas and become successful teams within the tasks they are given. They will also be given an opportunity where they will have to present as a team, this will also be assessed.

**Reading:** In term 1, we were reading novels in small groups and building up our knowledge of spelling to help us become more confident in reading. This term we will continue with our current novels and will then decide as a class whether we would like to continue in small groups or choose a class novel. (If not this term, we will choose to do a class novel in term 3). We will also continue to focus on our comprehension skills once a week by engaging in a range of texts and questioning to help us extend our comprehension skills.

**Writing:** Reflecting on last term, the children were developing their writing skills in imaginative writing during our Collaborative Writing Sessions with Mrs Milne and P6/5, This term our focus will be on Non Fiction writing and the children will be given the opportunity to write about a range of topics related to Non Fiction to increase awareness of the skills and techniques needed when writing Non Fiction pieces.

## Numeracy

In Numeracy, our key topics will be Money, 2D and 3d Shape and Data Handling, in particular focussing on different ways to highlight information and figures.

Our focus on Money will be prominently linked to our topic Business and Enterprise where we shall look at how Money is important in our everyday lives. We will learn about

- Banking: Debit and Credit Cards, Bank Statements, Loans and even Mortgages.
- Businesses: Profit/Loss and Wages.

We will also investigate other areas in which the children would like to find out about and this will be done during our planning of this topic.

## Topic: Business and Enterprise

Our topic this term will be "Business and Enterprise" and we will explore the world of Business and Work. We will look at Worldwide, National and Local Businesses, how to make a business successful and key elements that are essential business skills such as Finance, Advertising and Product Design. When looking at the world of work we will develop our knowledge of what CVs are and how to write one, how to apply for jobs and look at interviewing styles. The children will also be given an Enterprise task where they will work in teams to create their own product by using the knowledge they have gained throughout our topic.

\*\*\*For the children who were in my class last year, this will further develop their knowledge and enable them to explore new areas of this wide topic.
